Attached to this email, you will find the Lector schedule for **Palm Sunday** (April 14<sup>th</sup>) and the **Paschal Triduum** (April 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>st</sup> 2019 and Easter Sunday will be April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2019)

**It is vitally important that if you are unable to serve at the assigned place that you email me as soon as possible.**

Those readers who have been assigned to the **Proclamation of the Passion** should attend a rehearsal being held at **Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup>** as follows:

- **Readers (optionally Greeters and Head Ushers): 12pm – 12:30pm**
- **Acolytes and Clergy: 1:00pm to 1:30pm**

We will also provide additional ‘quick’ overview rehearsal prior to the Triduum, as follows:

**Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at 12:30pm**  
**Thursday, April 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm**  
**Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm**  
**Saturday, April 20<sup>st</sup> at 6:00pm**

**Please Note: This year we will be using a revised Passion Play - 7 voices are needed.** Therefore, we will practice the Passion readings apart from any rehearsal to save time for everyone.

The **Palm Sunday readers** should also note that there is an extra reading that occurs *outside*. Other than that, the readings are following the same format a regular Mass day except the Passion Play (noted above). Greeters are *not required* to attend the rehearsal, but it is *encouraged* especially for Vigil due to the movement needed and darkness.

For those readers assigned this year we will read FIVE Old and ONE New Testament at the ***Easter Vigil***, you will find the readings in your Lector’s Workbooks, and they will be emailed to you (or see below). The readings are as follows:

**Old Testament Readings:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Gen 1:1—2:2
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Ex 14:15—15:1
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Reading – Is 55:1-11
- 5<sup>th</sup> Reading – Is 55:1-11
- 7<sup>th</sup> Reading – Ez 36: 16-17a, 18-28

**New Testament Reading:**

- 8<sup>th</sup> Reading: Rom 6: 3-11
